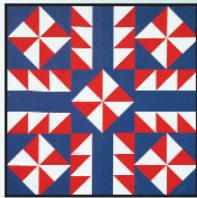

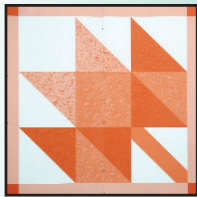

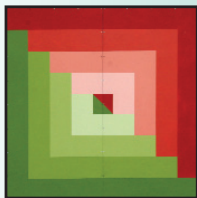

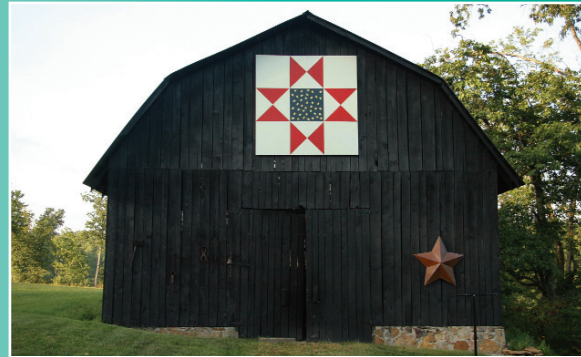

Rockcastle County is located 45 minutes south of Lexington, Kentucky. With a population of 16,500, Rockcastle County offers both a small town atmosphere and scenic beauty. Located just off Interstate 75 at exits 59 & 62, the county is home to the towns of Mt. Vernon, Brodhead and Livingston.

You are invited to visit the art and craft shops, Mt. Vernon's Historical Stores, Renfro Valley Entertainment Center, the Kentucky Music Hall of Fame, BitterSweet Cabin Village, Lake Linville, and the Rockcastle River.

Travel the back roads to see family farms, forests, streams, and wildlife where redbud trees provide a blanket of purple and pink in the spring. Lush green foliage abounds during the summer months, giving away to shades of red and green in the fall. Quilt Barns dot the landscape providing a special tribute to the creativity of the people of the area.

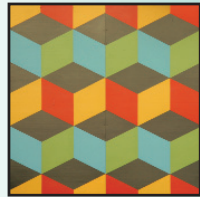
*There are over 21 individual quilt squares scattered throughout the hills and valleys of Rockcastle County.*

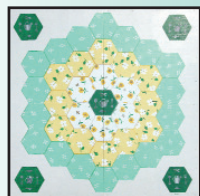

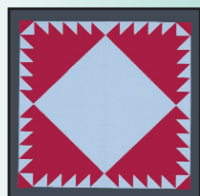

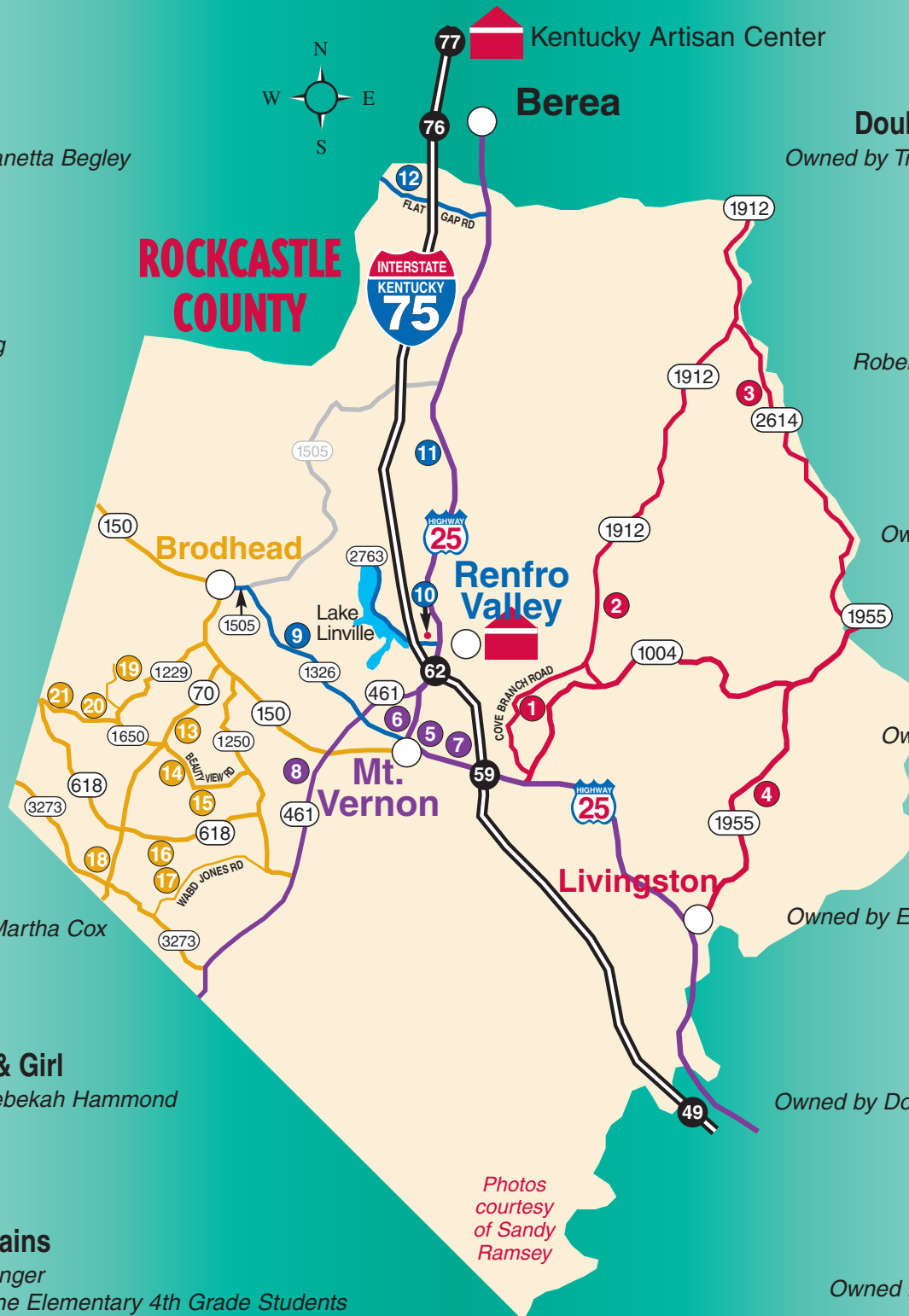

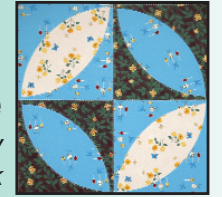
